Dear Mr. Mike Morningstar,

The CTFI has received your application to become a member of our Federation. After consulting with the CTFI Executive Board and Master Tran President of the ITF, we have come up with the following decision.

Since you were expelled in 2002 by the ITF, only after the next ITF congress in 2007 could you be reinstated. The CTFI will allow you and your members in the Province of Ontario to be members for a probation period from the above date of this letter until the ITF congress in 2007, at which time the ITF will decide if you will be reinstated. Following the decision, the CTFI will take the appropriate measures and sanctions.

As part of your probation, during this period you will not be able to test any students for Black Belt and your schools will be under the CTFI's Technical Director, Master Pierre Laquerre. You cannot hold any positions on the Ontario Provincial Taekwon-Do Federation or the CTFI Board. You and your clubs in Ontario are subject to all CTFI rules and regulation dues and fees during this time.

You will return as the same rank you left which was 5th Degree.

Any other clubs associated with you outside of the Province of Ontario must make separate application to the CTFI directly.
