The IIC course will cover Chon-Ji to Tong-II. The Grand Masters will help us expand our knowledge and standardize technique. Subjects covered such as: Patterns, Self-Defense, Step Sparring and Theory of Power.

There will be a special class for the Do, by Dr. Gauthier and Master Joliette Trân as speakers. Why the DO part is relevant to you? Studying the Do is an essential component of learning Taekwon-Do. Without studying and promoting moral values, Taekwon-Do is merely a sport of combat, not a true martial art. Taekwon-Do should never be taught without teaching the way of life (i.e., the Do), which is the true nature and spirit of the martial arts.

- All participants shall wear a clean and always ironed official ITF dobok.
- Before each new session participants will line up to welcome the Grand Masters

- Participants standing at ease must always assume a ready stance with their hands behind their back.
- Participants sitting on the floor at ease must always cross their legs.
- Participants are allowed to ask questions; the student shall stand and assume ready stance with their hands behind their back.

- For other candidates, send the application through the National/Allied Association at least one (1) month before the promotion date to the ITF Administration HQ.
